We would like to draw your attention to an information meeting organized in London on the 4th of November 2016 by the [Foundation for Polish Science](#) (FNP) in cooperation with [King's College London](#), [Universities UK](#) and [British Embassy in Warsaw](#).

“Polish Info Day” will be an international careers event aimed at the UK research community and will be focused on **funding opportunities** available for **individual researchers** willing to conduct their research in Poland. Presentations will be given by representatives of all the main funding agencies in Poland, including [National Science Centre](#), [National Centre for Research and Development](#) and the [Foundation for Polish Science](#).

The agenda of the meeting includes also a presentation of the [FNP International Research Agendas Programme](#) which aims at creating new research centres of excellence in Poland. The programme is shaped on the Horizon 2020 Teaming for Excellence launched by the European Commission and in the next 7 years Poland will allocate over **120 million Euro** to implement it. Each new research center funded by the [International Research Agendas Programme](#) will be created in close collaboration with an **excellent partner institution from abroad**.
