We would like to draw your attention to an information meeting organized in Glasgow on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November 2016 by the <u>Foundation for Polish Science</u> (FNP) in cooperation with University of Glasgow, Universities Scotland and British Embassy in Warsaw.

"Polish Info Day" will be an international careers event aimed at the Scottish research community and will be focused on **funding opportunities** available for **individual researchers** willing to conduct their research in Poland. Presentations will be given by representatives of all the main funding agencies in Poland, including National Science Centre, National Centre for Research and Development and the Foundation for Polish Science.

The agenda of the meeting includes also a presentation of the FNP International Research Agendas Programme which aims at creating new research centres of excellence in Poland. The programme is shaped on the Horizon 2020 Teaming for Excellence launched by the European Commission and in the next 7 years Poland will allocate over **120 million Euro** to implement it. Each new research center funded by the International Research Agendas Programme will be created in close collaboration with an **excellent partner institution from abroad**.
