RESOLUTION NO 88/2021
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE

of 30 September 2021

**on the international call “ Supporting the protection of biodiversity and ecosystems
across land and sea”
launched under the European Biodiversity Partnership “Rescuing Biodiversity to
Safeguard Life on Earth”**

Pursuant to Article 20 (1) (4) and Article 20 (1) (7) of the Act on the National Science Centre of 30 April 2010 (uniform text in Journal of Laws 2019, item 1384), in conjunction with a letter from the Minister of Education and Science of 23 September 2021 requesting that the National Science Centre act as a national partnership coordinator for “Rescuing Biodiversity to Safeguard Life on Earth” carried out under the Horizon Europe 2021-2027, the Council of the National Science Centre hereby lays down the following terms of the call “Supporting the protection of biodiversity and ecosystems across land and sea” (hereinafter referred to as the „Call”) launched by the National Science Centre within the framework of the partnership:

- 1) the Call shall be launched according to the terms of and regulations on awarding funding for research tasks funded or co-funded under international calls launched by the National Science Centre and carried out as multilateral collaboration UNISONO, laid down in NCN Council Resolution No 80/2021 of 9 September 2021 ;
- 2) the Call shall be open to funding proposals for projects involving basic and applied research laid down in Article 4 (2) of the Act on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (consolidated text in Journal of Laws 2021, item 478), in any scientific disciplines covered by NCN review panels adopted by the NCN Council,
- 3) applicants for which project funding constitutes state aid shall not be eligible to apply to the Call.
