RESOLUTION NO 113/2023

OF THE COUNCIL OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE

of 7 December 2023

on the following international calls: CHIST-ERA Call 2023, JPND Call 2024, JPIAMR Call 2024

Pursuant to Article 20 (1) (4) of the Act on the National Science Centre of 30 April 2010 (consolidated text in Journal of Laws of 2023, item 153) and §4 of the Terms and Regulations on awarding funding for research tasks funded or co-funded under international calls launched by the National Science Centre and carried out as multilateral collaboration UNISONO laid down in NCN Council Resolution No 32/2023 of 16 March 2023, the Council of the National Science Centre has decided as follows:

Applicants for which project funding constitutes state aid shall not be eligible to submit NCN proposals under the following calls:

- CHIST-ERA IV Call 2023 targeting research in the following topics: Multidimensional Geographic Information Systems (MultiGIS); Smart Contracts for Digital Transformation Ecosystems (SmartC), launched by the European Coordinated Research on Long-term Challenges in Information and Communication Sciences & Technologies (CHIST-ERA network);
- JPND Call 2024 targeting research in the following topic: Mechanisms and measurement of disease progression in the early phase of neurodegenerative diseases, launched by the Joint Programming Initiative in Neurodegenerative Diseases (JPND), and
- JPIAMR-ACTION Call 2024 targeting research in the following topic: Interventions Moving forward to Promote ACTion to counteract the emergence and spread of bacterial and fungal resistance and to improve treatments (IMPACT), launched by the Joint Programming Initiative on Antimicrobial Resistance (JPIAMR),
